

1.5.6 Rubrics + Grad Attributes

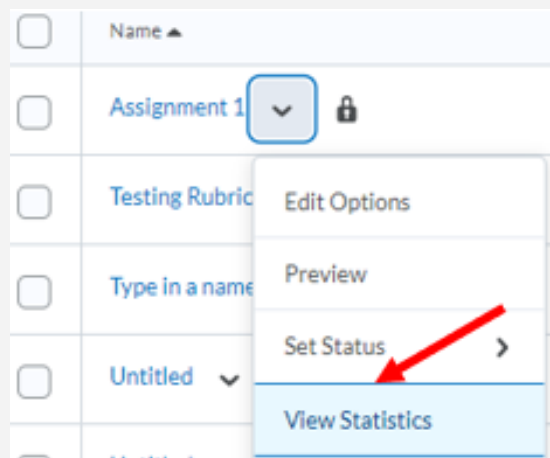
This tutorial suggests a way to do grad attributes in a more convenient fashion. There are many different ways, and this provides one of the fastest. Go through **Tutorials 1.5.4 + 1.5.5** first.

STEP 1

Create a rubric for each assessment you will have in your course. Make sure each of these rubrics covers all the attributes with right number of criteria. Also make sure these rubrics are linked to the assessment and are filled in during grading by TAs.

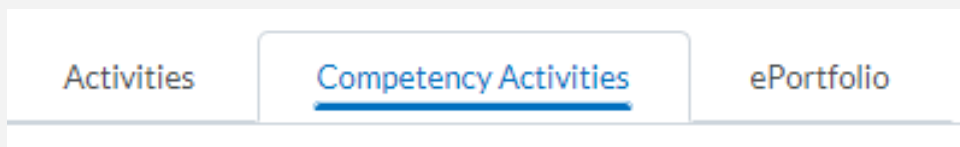
STEP 2

To get the statistics for your desired assignment, press the **drop down arrow** then select **View Statistics**.



STEP 3

Navigate to the tab **Competency Activities**.



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STEP 4

Now you will be able to see the average score for that assessment and the amount of students who submitted it.

STEP 5

To get more information for each specific criteria of your rubric, press the bar graph icon to the very right.
