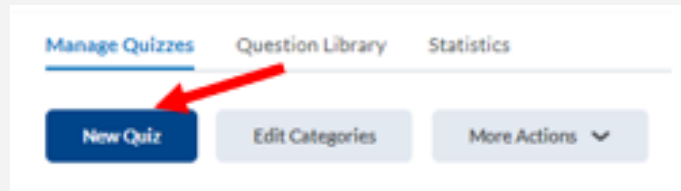


# 1.6 Making an Avenue Quiz

Quizzes on Avenue can be automatically graded and synced to the gradebook. This can save grading time if utilized properly. They can also be used as a quick way to check participation. Question types are gone into detail in further tutorials.



## STEP 1

Navigate to **Assessments** --> **Quizzes** from the Avenue homepage. Select **New Quiz**.



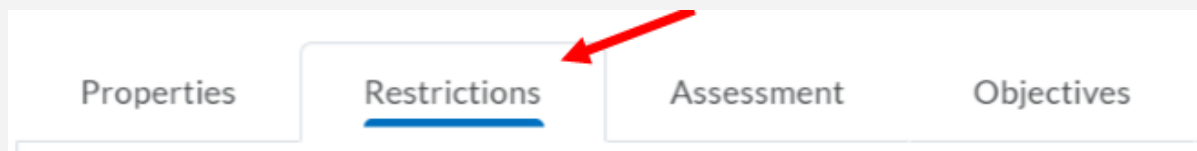
## STEP 2

Name your Quiz and add Quiz Questions. There are separate tutorials for each type of quiz question. If you are unfamiliar with question types and adding questions, proceed to rest of the **1.6 Tutorials** first.

## STEP 6

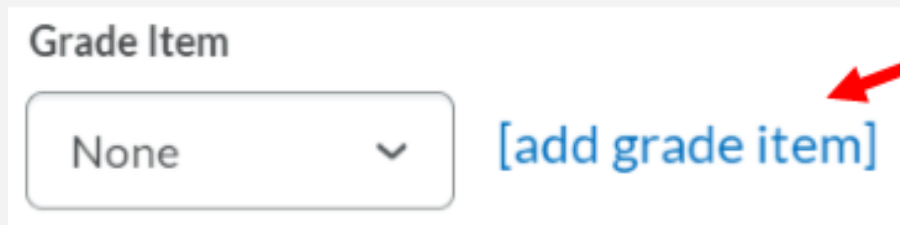
## STEP 7

Select the **Assessment** Tab at the top of the page




## STEP 8

Under Grade Item, select **add grade item**. If you have already set up the gradebook, simply select the entry you made in the gradebook. Otherwise, select **add grade item**. If the quiz is not for marks, there is no need to set up a grade item.



## STEP 9

If making a new grade item, choose a name. Under grading, set grade points and weight. Select **Save** when done.
