


## 1.6.3 Multiple Choice

This tutorial explores the Multiple Choice question type for quizzes. This tutorial assumes you are completing **Tutorial 1.6.1 step 3** and have selected Multiple Choice .

### STEP 1

Type in the question and the possible answers. Select which answer is correct using the bubbles to the left.


