


1.6.4 Multiselect Question

This tutorial explores the Multiselect Question type for quizzes. This tutorial assumes you are completing **Tutorial 1.6.1 step 3** and have selected Multiselect Question. Multiselect questions can be used for questions that have more than one correct answer.

STEP 1

Assign the grade points and type in the question text. You can also insert an optional image.

STEP 2

Select the way the question will be graded.

Grading

All or nothing Right minus wrong Correct answers

1.6.4 Multiselect Question

STEP 2 CONT

All or nothing: Students must select all correct answers in order to receive the points.

Right minus wrong: Incorrect selections will be subtracted from the correct selections and points will be determined from this result.

Ex. Student selects 3 answers with 2 correct and 1 incorrect – student gets a grade as if they had only selected 1 correct answer ($2-1=1$)

Correct Answers: Each option has equal value. If an option is correct and selected or an option is incorrect and not selected, the student will get credit.

Ex. Using the last example where 3 answers are selected and 2 are correct, students will be graded based on these 2 correct selections and the incorrect answer that was not selected.

Example:

Student input:

- Correct Answer
- Incorrect Answer
- Incorrect Answer
- Correct Answer



Grades, given the quiz is out of 1 point.

Grading	Grade
All or Nothing	0/1
Right Minus Wrong	0.5/1
Correct Answers	0.75/1

STEP 3

Under **Value**, write the text of one of the selection options. You can also write optional **Feedback** for students to see after they finish the quiz. If the statement is correct, check the box next to it.

#	Value	Correct	Feedback	Remove

Repeat this step for each option. To delete an option select the trash bin.

Add an optional question hint at the bottom of the page. When done, select **Save**.
