


1.6.5 Written Response Question

This tutorial explores the Written Question type for quizzes. This tutorial assumes you are completing **Tutorial 1.6.1 step 3** and have selected Written Question. In a Written Response Question, the instructor poses a question and students write in whatever text they choose. These questions cannot be marked automatically.

STEP 1

Type in the question text and assign the grade points. If you want students to be able to format responses select **Enable HTML Editor for student responses**. Select **Save** when done.
