


1.6.6 Short Answer Question

This tutorial explores the Short Answer Question type for quizzes. This tutorial assumes you are completing **Tutorial 1.6.1 step 3** and have selected Short Answer. This question type allows the instructor to pose a question and students can answer with one word or a short statement.

STEP 1

Type in the question text.

STEP 2


Type in a singular answer and press enter. Repeat for all possible answers.

Select **abc** to pick which expressions are valid entry.


