


## 1.6.7 Multi-Short Answer Question

This tutorial explores the Multi-Short Answer Question type for quizzes. This tutorial assumes you are completing **Tutorial 1.6.1 step 3** and have selected Multi-Short Answer. Multi Short Answer questions are helpful for questions with more than one answers. This can be used for questions involving cycles.

### STEP 1

Assign the grade points and type in the question text.


