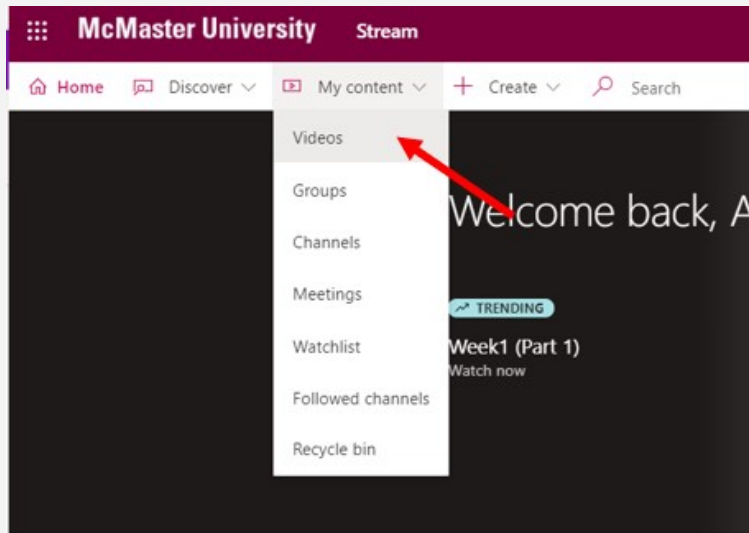


# 2.7 Linking Teams Recording to Avenue

This tutorial covers how to link videos made with Teams onto Avenue. If you wish to make your content downloadable, view **Tutorial 2.6** instead.

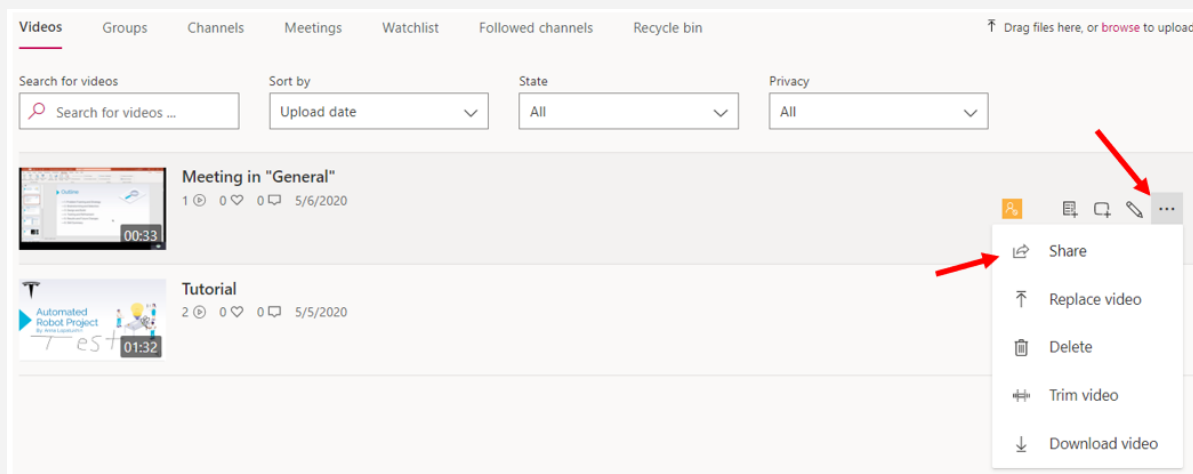
## STEP 1

Open Microsoft Streams, select **My Content** then **Videos** to see your content.



## STEP 2

Choose your video, select the **Three Dots** then **Share**.

## STEP 3

You can see your sharing options for the video. Navigate to the **Embed** tab. Select **Copy**.

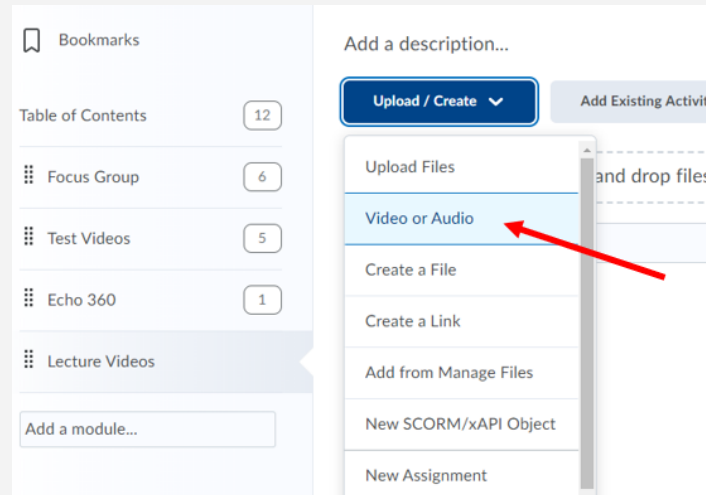

### STEP 4

Open Avenue and navigate to your desired module. Select **Upload/ Create** then **Video or Audio**

Paste the link you copied in step 3. Enter the appropriate title and select **Save**. The video will now be linked.
