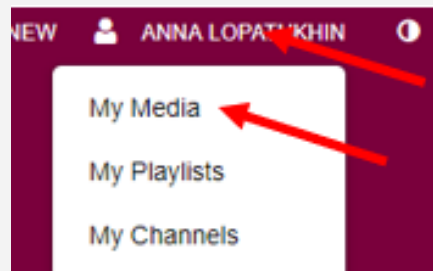


## 3.4 Editing on MacVideo

This tutorial covers how to access the editing features of MacVideo. More in-depth tutorials follow. If you are starting from the MacVideo home page, start at step 1. If you are continuing from **Tutorial 3.2** skip to Step 3.

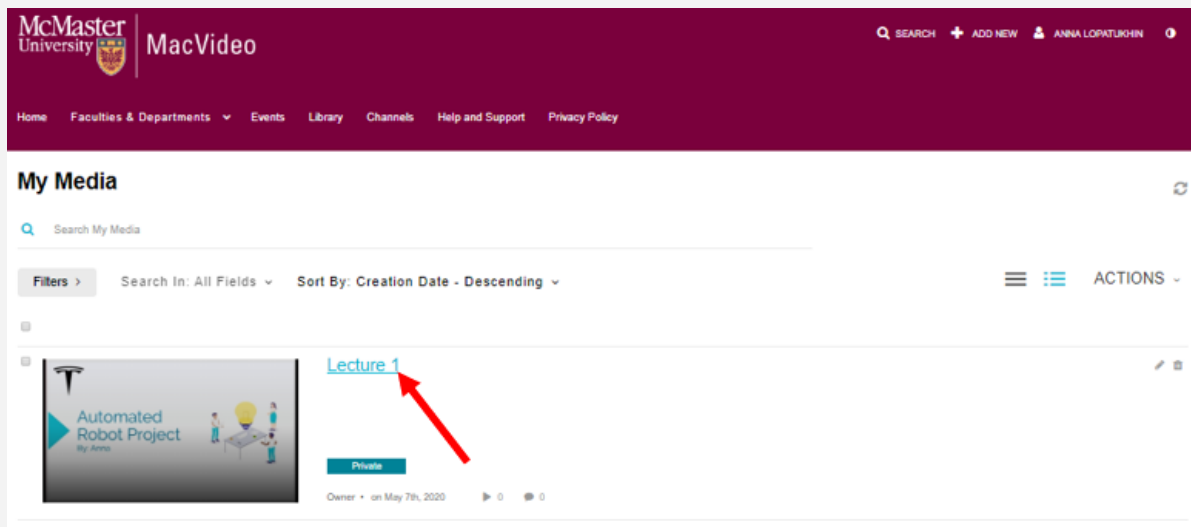
### STEP 1

Open the MacVideo website and make sure you are logged in. Select your name then **My Media** to view your video library.



### STEP 2

Select the **title** of the video you wish to edit.



## 3.4 Editing on MacVideo

### STEP 3

The video is now open. Select **Actions** to view your options.

- 1 Select **Edit** to change the name of your video and other descriptors. Most of the features in edit are not important, except **Captions**. MacVideo automatically generates captions for videos recorded with Kaltura. If possible, reviewing and editing the captions to be more accurate can be helpful for students. Read **Tutorial 3.4.3** for more information.
- 2 Selecting **Publish** will bring you to the permissions of your video. Read **Tutorial 3.4.1** for more information.
- 3 Select **Caption & Enrich** to request captions for your video if they have not been automatically generated.
- 4 Select **Launch Editor** to open more advanced video editing capabilities.
