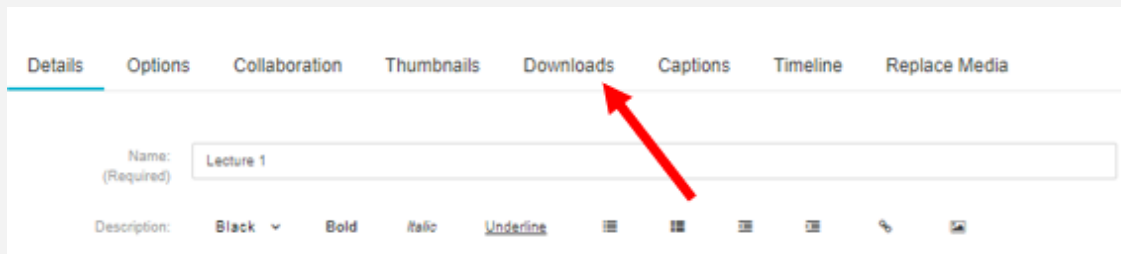


3.4.2 Creating Downloadable Videos

This tutorial covers how to make your video downloadable for students. It assumes you understand how to access editing features using **Tutorial 3.4**. This is beneficial for students with poor internet that cannot support video streaming.

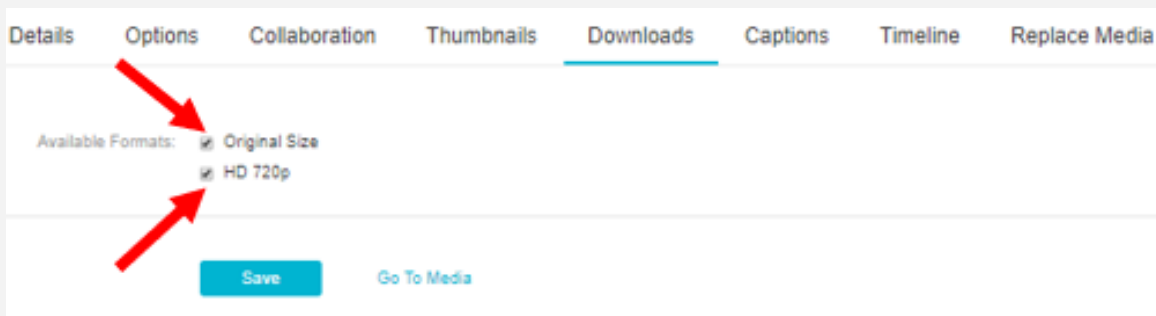
STEP 1

Open your video, access the settings by selecting **Actions** → **Edit**. From the **Edit** feature, select **Downloads**.



STEP 2


Select both options and press **Save**.

STEP 1

You will see a new **Download** section on your video.
