

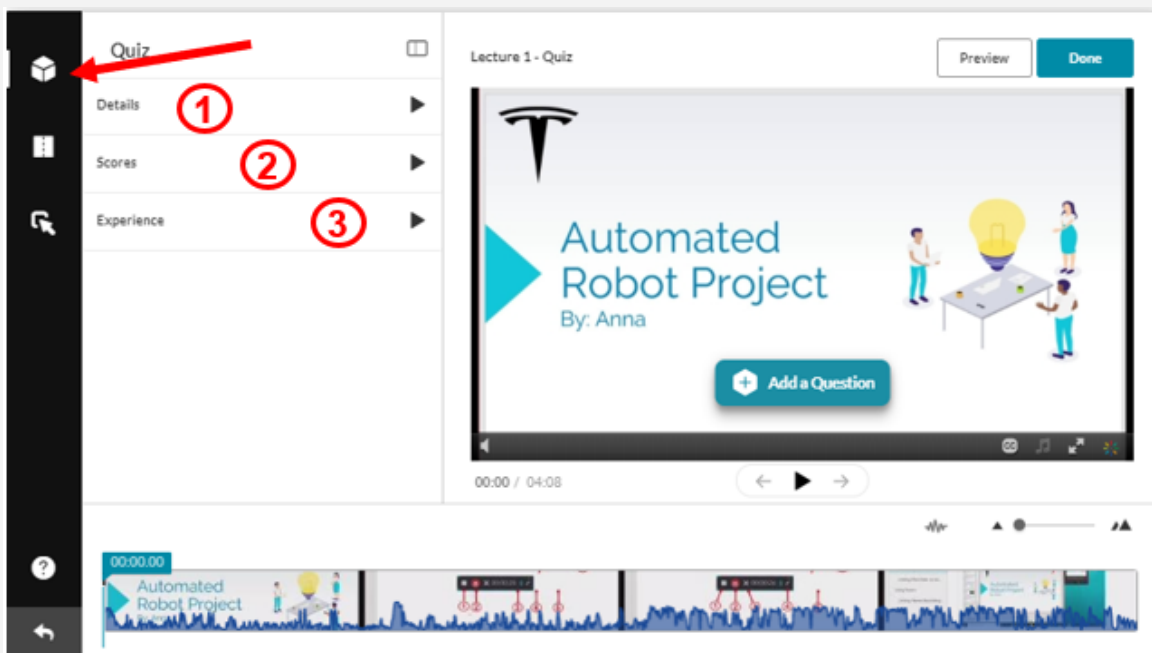
## 3.4.4 Creating Quizzes in Launch Editor

This tutorial covers creating quizzes in launch editor. It assumes you understand how to access editing features using **Tutorial 3.4**. Quizzes can be an effective tool to encourage student engagement in your recordings.

NOTE: When you create quizzes your original video is saved and a new video is created that contains the updated quizzes.

### STEP 1

Open your video, access the settings by selecting **Actions** → **Launch Editor**. From the Launch **Editor** feature, select the **Quiz** tab



1

**Details:** This tab controls the quiz name and if students see a welcome message when opening up the video

2

**Scores:** This controls how many attempts students have and if they can see their score after submission.

3

**Experience:** Here you can select if students are allowed to skip quiz questions and change their answers.

## 3.4.4 Creating Quizzes in Launch Editor

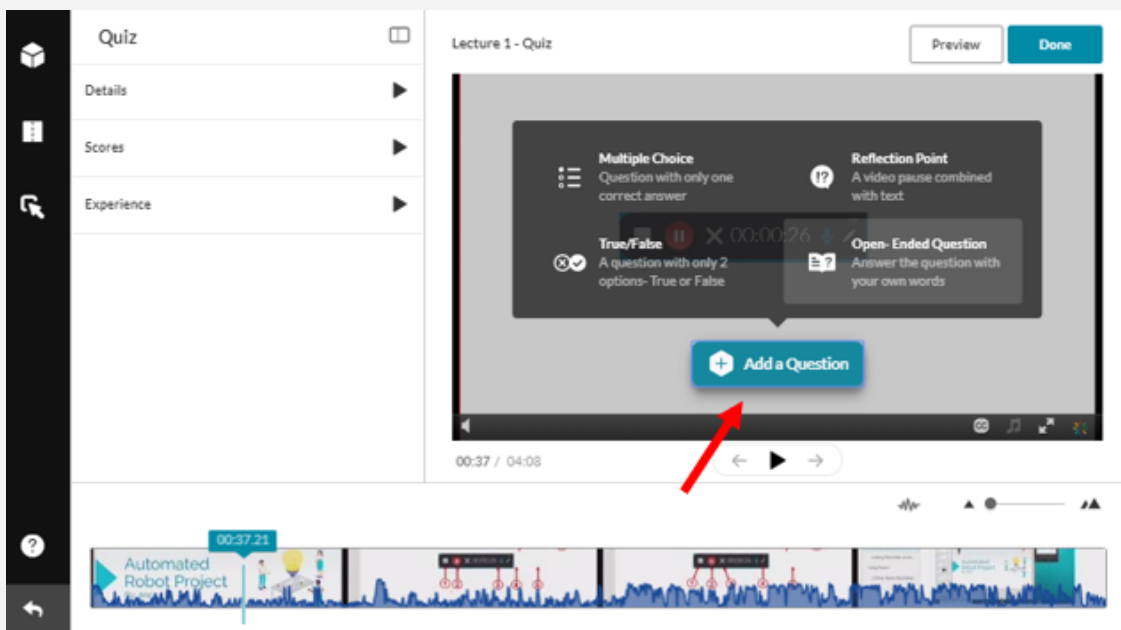
### STEP 2

Before adding a quiz, you must decide at what time in the recording you wish to have it. Select the blue time bar and drag it to your preferred time



### STEP 3

Once you are at the right time, select **Add a Question** to start creating your quiz, select the question type you desire and follow the prompts to complete the quiz



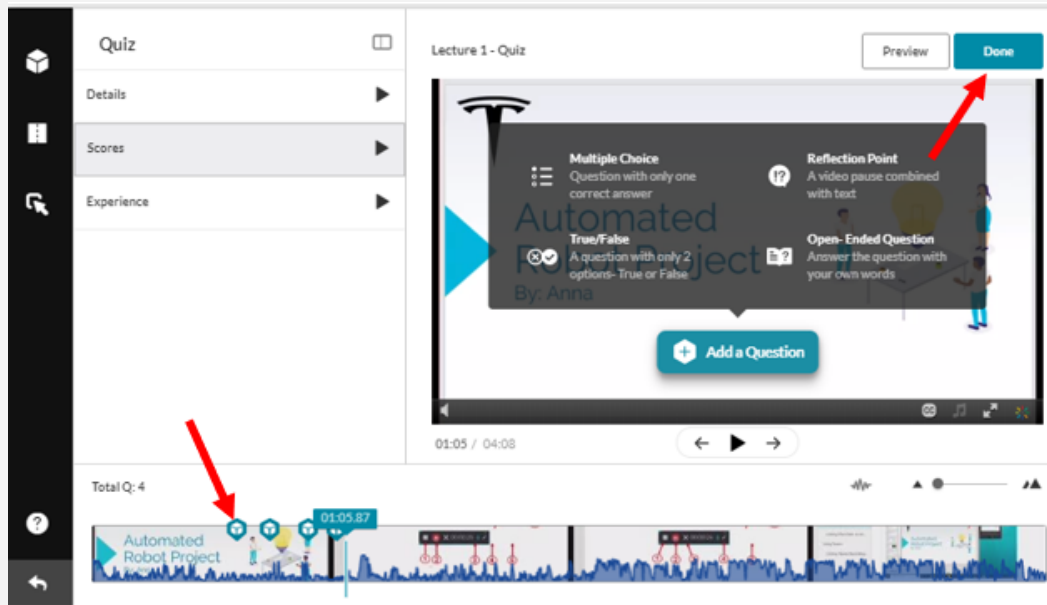
MacVideo supports the following types of quiz questions:

- Multiple choice (with one correct answer)
- True/False
- Reflection point (text entry)
- Open-ended question (text entry)

## 3.4.4 Creating Quizzes in Launch Editor

### STEP 4

Once you have successfully created a quiz, you will see the following popup on the video timeline. When finished editing, select **Done**.



### STEP 5

You can now **Preview** your video, **Edit Quiz**, or finish your work by selecting **Go to Media**.
