
3.5 Linking MacVideo to Avenue

This video covers linking MacVideo to Avenue. First, make sure your video is set to **Unlisted** using **Tutorial 3.4.1**.It is not required, but highly recommended you also review the subtitles and allow the video to be downloadable with **Tutorial 3.4.2** and **3.4.3**.


STEP 1

Open Avenue and navigate to the **Content** tab from the homepage. Open your desired module, select **Add Existing Activities** then **Add MacVideo Media Quicklink**.



STEP 2

Your videos will automatically appear if properly synced with MacVideo. Select your video.




STEP 4 Open your video on MacVideo from My Media under your name. Select Share and copy the Link To Media Page URL.

STEP 5

On Avenue, select the **Drop Down Arrow** next to the video you just uploaded and select **Edit Properties In-Place**.



STEP 6

Select **Add a Description** and paste the link from step 4. Select **Up-date** and the changes will be saved.
