


Using your Android Tablet and Computer Simultaneously on Teams

This tutorial covers how to use your Android while having your computer webcam on at the same time. This tutorial assumes you have installed Teams on your computer and Android. This method required no additional software, but may be glitchy for some users.

STEP 1


Start up Teams on your computer and start a meeting in the proper channel. Make sure your mic is on and make sure your webcam is on if you want to be seen. You should see a screen like this:

STEP 2


Open Teams on your Android and navigate to the channel you've started the meeting in. You should be able to join the meeting by touching the Join button.

STEP 3


Very Important – Make sure your **microphone**, **camera** and the **volume** on your tablet is **OFF**. There will be a **lot** of feedback if this step is not followed




Using your iPad and Computer Simultaneously on Teams

STEP 4

Share your tablets screen by clicking **...** on your screen then clicking Share (I use share screen) from teams and then your tablets screen will be shown in Teams.



You will see everything you are doing on your tablet shared on your desktop with your webcam, the meeting will look like this to all watching:



STEP 5

Record your Teams meeting as normal FROM YOUR COMPUTER. You can use the function within Teams or use one of the screen recording softwares like Kaltura Capture.
