

## Wacom Tablet Tips

- Practice writing in a number of font sizes in order to find what is most comfortable. You can always zoom in on notes when writing on them if its more comfortable to write in large letters
- If you find yourself clicking buttons as you write, you can disable the buttons in the Wacom Desktop app so that it does not mess with your notes
- Try not to look at the tablet when learning, it becomes easier to use when you aren't thinking about it
- If you hover the pen over the tablet you can always see where your cursor is
- Use the cursor to your advantage, it makes it easier to navigate and write
- Practice using the tablet as a mouse, this helps you get used to the writing surface and how it relates to your computer screen
- Don't use dual screens when writing with the Wacom tablet. The Tablets area stretches making your writing stretch as well
- Wacom tablets are very popular tools, there are many resources on the internet if you want to discover all of its possibilities or if you forget the basic functions
